- accept the Society's disciplinary process should there be any complaint about their alleged failure to comply with the Rules of Professional Conduct.

Any TPS member wanting to use MTPS as a post-nominal must sign an undertaking that they have read, have understood and will comply with the Code of Professional Conduct, and ensure that their TPS subscription is fully paid.
