

## TPP and Professional Development Workshop, London

- the Portfolio of Evidence competency requirements;
- preparing the Portfolio of Evidence;
- preparing for the Professional Review interview and the interview itself; and
- the benefits of being a TPP.

It will be assumed that those participating have a basic understanding of the TPP qualification including the various routes open to candidates and the principles of the competence requirements.
