
TPS Awareness Seminar – Part 2: TECHNICAL PAPER PRESENTATIONS EVENING

The Transport Planning Society West Midlands brings to you the second in a three part series of technical presentations for 2010. There are three speakers lined up for the evening from WSP, AECOM and Mott MacDonald that have kindly offered to present. The three technical paper presentations are as follows:

- **1. Travel Plans: A Developer's Perspective Stephen Yeates (WSP Group)** Stephen has recently undertaken research regarding a developer's perspective of travel plans. This paper aims to provide a new perspective of travel plans through a review of existing literature and policy, and a series of qualitative interviews. This research was conducted as part of an MSc undertaken at Loughborough University.
- **2. Innovations in GIS: A Key Transport Planning Tool James Colclough (AECOM)** GIS has been used for a number of years within the field of transport planning. More recently, we have seen a shift in the use of this technology from acting as a support tool, mainly for presentation purposes, to a key analytical system and a means of disseminating spatial information. This paper discusses where we have come from and more importantly where we are going.
- **3. New Guidance Paper for Signalised Roundabouts Colin Ridding (Mott MacDonald)** A Local Transport Note (LTN) 1/09 Signal Controlled Roundabouts, released by the DfT in April 2009, is a much needed and long awaited document that will for the first time provide users with a clear and practical guide to assist with the assessment, design and implementation of signalised roundabouts. The document was developed following a two year research project by Mott MacDonald.
