- Has the Scottish devolution debate opened up English cities to a transport and land use revolution?
- Will the Government recognise in its forecasting and funding that demand management is not only effective but essential?
- There are plans for major spending on transport but will it achieve objectives for the economy, health, environment and carbon reductions?

The session will cover ten areas of policy, including:

- Local rail capacity;
- Transport and Health;
- New Governance: combined authorities, Highways England and beyond; and
- Travel behaviour change.

The session will be run by Board members **Keith Buchan** (Policy Lead), **Nick Richardson** (Chair of TPS) and **Christopher Blake**. It is very rare for the Midlands regions to have three members of the Board present at one meeting, so it will be a great opportunity to present your views for the Society's consideration.
