## Rules for the Transport Planning Society Photography Competition 2107

#### **How to Enter**

- Take or create an original digital photo and submit it with a short piece of explanatory text (not exceeding 50 words, following the guidelines in the Competition Rules. Up to 6 submissions will accepted for entry into the competition by each entrant.
- Email the file(s) to board@tps.org.uk between 1st Sept 21st Dec 2017 (by 2359 GMT).
- Submission of an entry will be taken to mean acceptance of the Competition Rules.
- Additional submissions in excess of 6 photographs will be accepted (and are welcome), but will not be entered into the competition. If you wish to make additional submissions, please clearly indicate those you wish entered into the competition itself.

#### **General Rules**

- The competition is open to all members of the Transport Planning Society and companies participating in the Professional Development Scheme. Current elected board members and co-opted board members are permitted to submit images but are not eligible for any of the prizes.
- Each entrant is permitted to submit a maximum of 6 images. Submissions must not include any endorsements of products or services, or any obscene, violent, racist or defamatory content. Entries that do not comply will be automatically disqualified.
- If your photograph is focused on an identifiable individual, you must ensure that you have their consent to appear in the image.

### **Image Requirements**

Digital photos must be of high resolution. Any poor quality / low-resolution images will be rejected. The format(s) used must be either .jpg / .jpeg /.png

### **Judging Criteria**

The judging panel will be made up of members of the TPS board. The images will be judged on both quality and relevance to the TPS.

The organisers and judges reserve the right to remove any entries from the competition that they feel may breach any of the Competition rules, the Terms and Conditions or may bring the competition into disrepute. Such entries will be disqualified.

### **Prizes and notification of Winners**

The three photographers judged to have taken the best pictures will be awarded cash prizes of £100 each. Winners will be notified by email and arrangements will be made to award the prizes. Winners may be asked to attend a TPS event to be presented with their award and may be requested to appear in newsletter / website items relating to the competition.

Copyright of the materials submitted for this contest remains with the respective entrants. However, each entrant grants the Transport Planning Society the right to use the submitted materials to promote TPS, develop its website, and in relevant publications / presentations.
