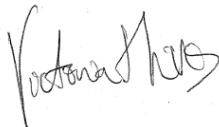

There are two ways for you to register your vote. Firstly, for ease of administration, we would appreciate you returning your completed ballot paper to the ICE by Monday 22 February. Alternatively, you can register your vote in person before the start of the AGM, provided that you bring your ballot form with you.

In addition, we are asking members to vote on a Resolution, which seeks member agreement to change the quorum (the number of members) that are required at any future General Meetings (including the AGM) where business is to be transacted. Further details and a voting form are enclosed.

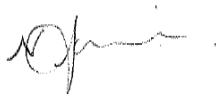
