How to offer a work placement

The work placements should be for 4-5 months, from April – August 2020. TPS is acting as a conduit with ENTPE to make you aware of the opportunity to offer work placements and to introduce the students to you. If you would like to offer a work placement to one or more, we ask you to contact the student(s) directly by e-mail and make the necessary arrangements.

As the work placement forms part of the student's formal education, there is an agreement to be signed between ENTPE and the employer setting out the responsibilities of both parties. The student can explain more. (If required, TPS can supply a preview copy of the Agreement at info@tps.org.uk)

There is no need to inform TPS of your actions but come back to us if you would like any further information about ENTPE or the work placement arrangements in general.

Remuneration – Civil Servants and Independent students

Although TPS will not be involved in any contractual arrangements you may make with the students, we highlight two key points.

The summary table shows that some of the students are French civil servants. These students are on a French government salary and are forbidden, by French law, from receiving a second salary. They may nevertheless appreciate some assistance with their living expenses in the UK or Ireland. On the other hand, the independent students are not bound to the civil service and while they would reasonably expect a fair remuneration, they may also offer the prospect of a longer-term relationship with you.

Please note that if a work placement is agreed before 31st January 2020, the student will be eligible for an additional ERASMUS grant, which could reduce your own financial commitment.

Background to ENTPE and the French Education System (which the students refer to in their CV's)

ENTPE is one of the Grandes Ecoles (the elite universities) in France, and this is the top transport and land use planning school in the country.

Entry to the school requires the students to follow their normal school-leaving exams (the Baccalauréat) with a two-year intensive period of state organized academic study (the Classe Préparatoire aux Grandes Ecoles or CGPE). Following competitive exams at the conclusion of CGPE, successful students are then offered places at Grandes Ecoles like ENTPE. A further entry requirement to ENTPE is that all students must be fluent in English.

The school is classified as an “Engineering School” so the students tend to have an academic background (including the CGPE) in the sciences.

The school teaches a 3-year combined transport and land use planning course, so that students graduating from the School will have completed 5 years of post-Baccalauréat study. A requirement of the course is that students must undertake two periods of work placement, at least one of which must be outside France.

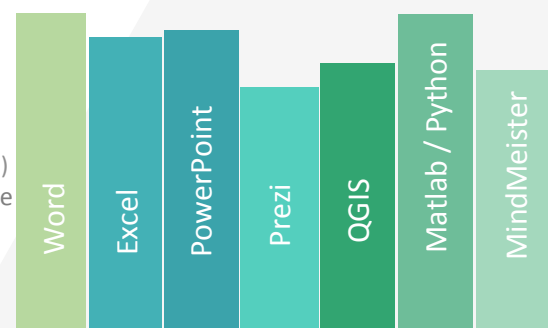

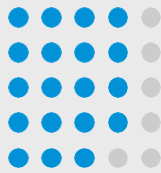

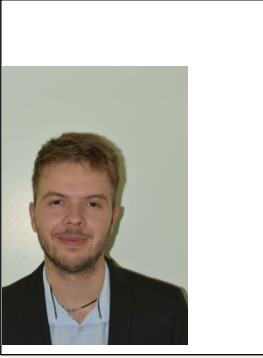
