NEW TRANSPORT PLANNING PROFESSIONAL (TPP) QUALIFICATION

The IHT in partnership with TPS, have recently launched a new Transport Planning Professional (TPP) qualification, designed to provide professional recognition for Transport Planners. The IHT Branch and TPS Region are delighted to welcome Martin Richards and Derek Palmer who will be giving a presentation on the new qualification. The qualification enables transport planners to gain recognition for their particular technical skills and knowledge in the same way that CEng recognises professional engineers. The access routes are designed to allow transport planners from any academic background to work towards the qualification. Martin and Derek will briefly outline the background to the qualification, the competence standards and assessment procedures.
