## **Public transport:**

Leicester station is approximately 4 miles from County Hall, with regular train services from Nottingham, Derby, Sheffield, Birmingham and London St. Pancras.

A direct bus leaves from outside the station to the Glenfield Hospital (the UHL Hospital Hopper). This is a ten minute walk from County Hall. Please note PlusBus tickets are not valid on this service

Alternatively please use local bus services into Leicester city centre to connect with the 26, 27 and 29 (Arriva). These serve County Hall from Leicester St. Margarets Bus station. PlusBus is valid on these services.

County Hall is located just off the A50 (Groby Road) at the roundabout interchange with Gynsills Lane and Station Road, Glenfield.

It can be accessed via the A46 Leicester Western Bypass at Junction 21a of the M1 (northbound) or the A50 at Junction 22 (both directions).
