Professional Qualifications and Development for Transport Planners

The Transport Planning Professional (TPP) qualification is becoming increasingly widely recognised by both employers and organisations commissioning transport planning projects, and the complementary TPS Professional Development Scheme (PDS) has been adopted by 21 employers, including Atkins, Mouchel, Transport for London, Leicestershire County Council. More are expected to join soon with a view of providing a structured training scheme for transport planners, particularly those planning to seek the TPP qualification.

Martin will describe both the TPP and TPS PDS and provide guidance to those considering applying for the TPP qualification.
