In November 2008, the Department for Transport published "Delivering a Sustainable Transport System" (DaSTS), which set out the work that regions are invited to undertake to influence the Government's decisions on transport investment from 2014 onwards. DaSTS sets out a series of goals and challenges for the transport networks, with clear roles for national Government and regional agencies in developing a long-term strategy for these transport networks.

The consultants Atkins have been appointed by 4NW, the Regional Leaders Board along with the Northwest Regional Development Agency to assist in the process of determining strategic priorities and a robust work programme of studies to December 2010. The Department for Transport has indicated that approximately £1 million of funding per annum could be made available to the region in order to undertake the work programme.
