Estimates of the cost of congestion are in the billions but measures to improve journey time, reliability and improve fleet efficiency are well within reach

The key to getting commercial vehicles to go along preferred routes is vital. Providing better signs, sharing preferred routes with operators and satellite navigation providers, the use of priority lanes and provision of traffic information all help to improve traffic management and planning
