'Towards a Sustainable Transport System (TaSTS) - how far towards it have we got so far?'

Towards a Sustainable Transport System (TaSTS), published by the DfT in October 2007, set out the Government's transport investment and policy plans to 2014 and proposals that would implement the recommendations of the Eddington and Stern reports. TaSTS also promised a Green Paper by July 2008 that would consult on the Government's proposals on the challenges it thinks should be addressed in the 2012 transport plan.

This formal consultation has now been postponed to the autumn, but in the interim the DfT published on 1st July a variety of documents representing emerging Government policy and inviting comments from interested parties. Mark Lambirth is leading this workstream from the DfT and will bring us up to date both on progress and the way forward. Garrett Emmerson, wearing his CfIT hat, will also give us his view of the emerging policy. The evening is intended not only to be informative but also to help transport professionals, and the TPS in particular, to be proactively involved in the development of this vital policy area.
